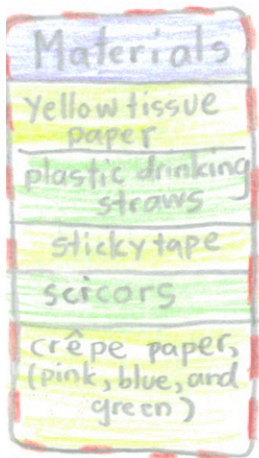


paper flowers



Like this:



1 Cut a strip of yellow tissue paper about 6cm wide and snip the strip with scissors to form a fringe

2 Wind the tissue paper fringe around the top of a drinking straw and wrap the bottom edge with a piece of sticky tape to hold it in place

3 Cut petal shapes from crêpe paper

4 Wrap the base of each petal, one by one, around the drinking straw "stem", holding them in place with short lengths of sticky tape.

5 Cut a strip of green crêpe paper and use this to bind the base of the flower, fixing it in place with tape.

6 Finally, gently pull each petal into shape.

You can make more in different colours.

SUPER EASY COOKIES

Ingredients:

250g softened butter
3/4 cup sugar
2 tsp vanilla
1 egg
1/4 tsp salt
2 1/2 cups flour
(wholegrain or plain)

Preheat oven to 180°C

Makes about 30 cookies

Bake for about 14 mins. Then cool on a rack.

- 1 Put the butter, sugar, egg, and vanilla in a large bowl and beat well until mixed
- 2 Sift in the flour and add the salt. Mix again to make a dough.
- 3 Split the dough in half and add 1 tbsp cocoa powder to one half. Press the dough to make a ball
- 4 Roll the dough between a folded piece of baking parchment until about 5mm thick
- 5 Cut out shapes with cookie cutters. Gather up the trimmings into a ball, then roll out again and make more shapes
- 6 Lift cookies onto a palette and arrange the shapes slightly apart on nonstick cookie sheets.

10 STEPS FOR

SAVING:

FIRST, save \$1000.

SECOND, pay off all debt.

THIRD, save for emergencies (enough to last you for 6 months)

FOURTH, save for retirement every month

FIFTH, save for university (op.)

SIXTH, pay off your mortgage

SEVENTH, earn a lot and give a lot!

You are never too young to start saving.

(note: if a step doesn't apply to you, skip it, (eg. mortgage or debt) but it may apply later in life.)

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3. Study the Psalms. Write down everything you've learned about testing and trusting God.

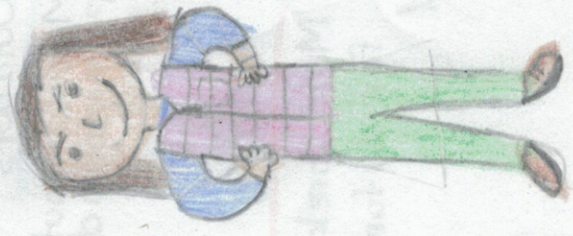
4. Read Foxe's Book of Martyrs.
