YARN OCTOPUS

Materials:

- 1 ball brightly colored yarn
- 30cm piece thick cardboard
- 1x ball scrunched-up foil
- (the size of a tennis ball)
- Googly eyes • Scissors
- scraps of yarn



1. Wind the yarn around the cardboard 40 times

2. Place a piece of yarn under the wound yarn at the top and tie firmly cut through the bundle of yarn at the bottom

3. Lay the center of the bundle over the ball.

4. Spread the strands of yarn evenly over the ball. Hold the ball firmly & tie a piece of yarn under the ball.

5. Divide the loose yarn into eight equal bunches. Braid each bunch. Secure the end of each braid with a piece of scrap yarn, tied in a bow.

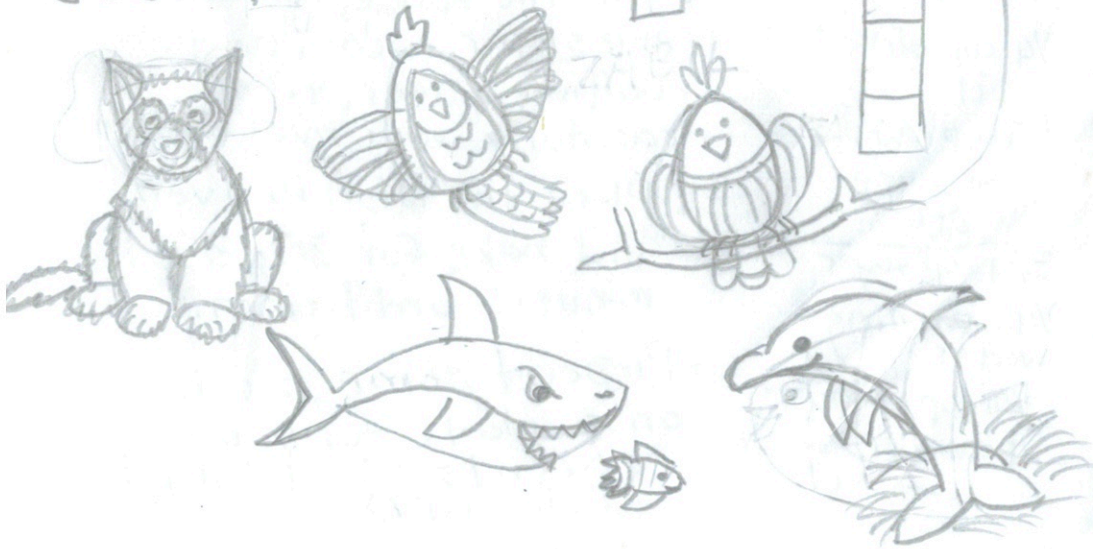

CHARACTER ACTIVITIES

1. Develop the habit of saying, "Yes, Dad," or "Yes, Mom," respectfully whenever your Dad or Mom speaks to you or gives you an instruction.

2. Make a list of specific ways in which you can show special honor and respect to elderly people in your life. Put them into action at every opportunity.
3. When you are making an important decision, ask the opinion of your father. Value his views.

4. Evaluate the books you read and the movies you watch. Do the characters respect and honor their parents and other people? Do they influence you to follow their example? Consider stopping reading/watching books/movies that are a bad influence on you.

5. Observe children who are disrespectful to their parents. What are the results of their disrespect? How is the reputation affected? How is God's reputation affected? What can you learn?

6. Make a list of specific actions that demonstrate disrespect, such as gestures, postures, words, facial expressions etc.

(7) SELF-SAUCING CHOCOLATE PUDDING

- Heat oven to 180°C and grease a casserole dish
- Put the flour, sugar, cocoa, and salt into a large bowl and mix.
- Whisk milk, oil, & vanilla together in a small bowl. Put into dry ingredients, then stir and pour into casserole dish.
- For the sauce, combine the sugar, cocoa, and boiling water, then carefully pour over batter
- Place the dish in oven and bake for 30-35 minutes until firm.
