

COMIC CHALLENGE

FAKE CUPCAKES

You will need:

Felt in brown,
white, and bright
colors.

Stuffing

Embroidery thread

Needle


Scissors

Pins

Templates on
Magazine back

1. Trace and cut out the templates. Pin the large circle onto felt in a bright color, the medium circle onto the brown felt, the small circle onto red or pink felt, and the frosting shape onto white or light pink felt. Cut out.

2. Sew the frosting shape to the cupcake shape w/running stitch



3. Now sew the cupcake shape to the middle of the cupcake case circle, making the stiches quite big. Leave a gap of about 3 cm for stuffing

4. Stuff the cupcake through the hole until it is nicely rounded, then sew up the gap.

5. Sew running stitch around the outside of the cherry shape and stuff it. Pull the thread to gather up the felt and stitch it to the middle of the frosting shape.
